Rosanna "before there were roads or a sewer" and stayed there for 45 years. He traded a backyard for a city apartment 12 years ago.

But, at 89, age has finally caught up with him. An uneven heartbeat and bionic bits in two shoulders and one knee were additions later in life. Half a lifetime of early starts also dented his sleeping patterns.

"In the navy I got to watch the sun rise and set everyday," he said. "Now I never go to bed before midnight. I don't sleep well, I am up during the night. "It's ingrained in you."

Mac has rejected the idea of retirement. He works late into the night on a historical website, helping find men and women lost at sea for families. "I don't know what I would do if I didn't have the website."

8:46am: Flight 11 crashes into the World Trade Center's North Tower

9:03am: Flight 175 crashes into the World Trade Center's South Tower

9:37am: Flight 77 crashes into the Pentagon, killing the 59 on board and 125 inside the building.

9:42am: The Federal Aviation Authority grounds all flights over, or bound for the continental United States.

9:59am: The World Trade Center's South Tower collapses

10:03am: Flight 93 crashes in a field in Pennsylvania, killing the 40 people on board

10:28am: The World Trade Center's North Tower collapses

8:30pm: President Bush addresses the nation for the first time since the attacks
